**01**

Plant low risk plants in your front yard where everyone can see them!

**02**

When chatting to neighbours, family, colleagues or friends about gardening, make sure you mention the Gardening Responsibly website so they can find out more.

**03**

Post photos of your low risk plants and gardens on your social media accounts and explain why they are so special to share the plant love. Tag us on your Facebook, Instagram or LinkedIn post so we can see your great work too!

Join a local gardening club and share your low risk plant knowledge with the group.

Chat to your local school or preschool about considering low risk plants for their site.

Visit your local nursery or plant supplier and see if they're a Scheme Member - if they're not, email them with a link to the website to make sure you can always access the latest low risk plants!

**09**

If you're a designer or landscaper, encourage your clients to consider low risk options and check your plant list or plant palette in our Research Portal.

**10**

If you're a plant wholesaler or retailer, make sure your low risk stock is clearly marked and easily accessible - and that staff are trained to explain how to garden responsibly.
