What is Gardening Responsibly?

Gardening Responsibly is a groundbreaking initiative that helps all Australians enjoy beautiful, healthy gardens while reducing the impact of future landscape-scale weed invasions.

At the heart of the Initiative is our Certified Gardening Responsibly eco-label – the gardening responsibly tick of approval. Only ornamental plants that have been assessed through our Research Portal as having a low future-invasive risk can get the tick, and only suppliers who have joined our Gardening Responsibly Scheme supply plants with the tick.

Gardening responsibly means ensuring you buy, sell and install ornamental plants that won't jump the garden fence and cause harm to the environment.




We want everyone to hear about Gardening Responsibly!


Example 3

Invasive weeds are impacting our uniquely Australian natural environments. Let's stop the spread together! Look for the Gardening Responsibly tick when purchasing your next plants.


